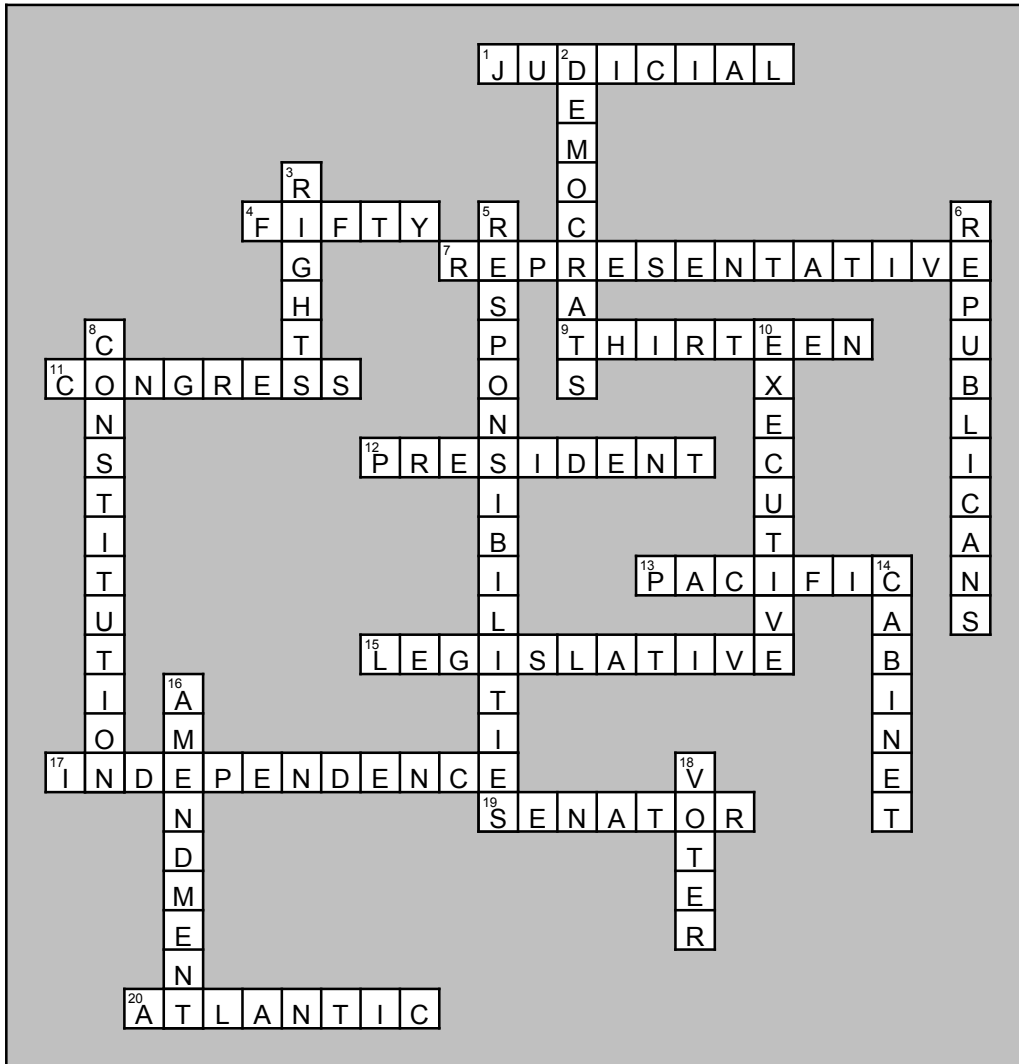


American Government Crossword

- the name for the two houses that make up the legislative branch
- the chief executive of the U.S. and commander in chief of its military
- the ocean that is on the West coast of the U.S.
- the branch of government that makes the laws
- We celebrate July 4, the day the Declaration of Independence was signed in 1776, as _____ Day.
- a member of the Senate, one of two representing each state.
- the ocean that is on the East coast of the U.S.

- people belonging to the same American political party as Presidents Obama, Clinton, and Kennedy
- powers a person is entitled to exercise-that no one may rightfully take away
- duties: the things each citizen should do
- people belonging to the same American political party as Presidents Bush (both), Reagan, and Lincoln
- supreme (most important) law of the land
- the branch of government that enforces the laws and runs the government
- the group of people the president chooses to advise him and to run the departments of the government (the Secretary of State, of Defense, of Labor, of Education, etc.)
