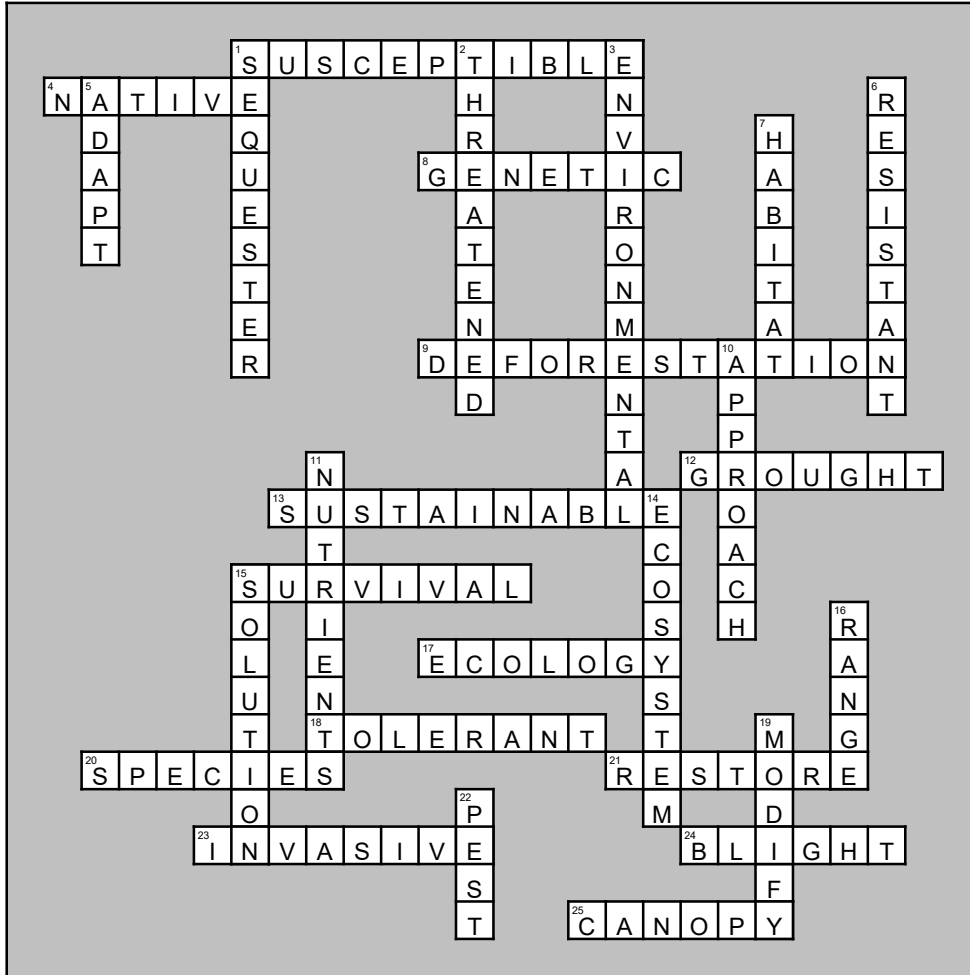

- vulnerable to damage from a particular threat
- belonging in a place (not introduced from somewhere else)
- related to genes (or inherited characteristics determined by genes)
- destruction of forests
- a long-term lack of water
- able to continue over a long period
- the ability to live or to continue to exist
- the science of the inter-relationships between living things and their environment
- able to handle or deal with something
- the basic unit of classification in biology: a group of closely-related plants or animals that are able to interbreed with each other
- to bring something back to its previous condition after a problem
- species coming from elsewhere that can dominate or take over an ecosystem and displace native species
- a kind of fungal disease that can destroy susceptible species of plants
- a covering above the top of something (in ecology, the uppermost branches shading a forest)

- to set something apart, out of reach
- in danger of harm or destruction
- related to the environment (the natural world we live in)
- to make changes to better fit new circumstances
- able to avoid being badly affected by something
- a species' natural environment
- a way of looking at or solving problems (or as a verb to move closer)
- components of food required for life, like proteins, carbohydrates, & vitamins
- a connected, interacting system or community of plants, animals, & their environment
- an answer to a problem
- the complete area that a species can live in
- to change something
- an unwanted or harmful plant, animal, or bug
